About the Event:

'Innovation in Science Pursuit for Inspired Research' (INSPIRE) scheme is one of the flagship programmes of Department of Science & Technology (DST), Government of India. The INSPIRE - MANAK (Million Minds Augmenting National Aspirations and Knowledge), being executed by DST with National Innovation Foundation – India (NIF), an autonomous body of DST, aims to motivate students in the age group of 10-15 years and studying in classes 6 to 10. The objective of the scheme is to target one million original ideas/innovations rooted in science and societal applications to foster a culture of creativity and innovative thinking among school children. Under this scheme, schools can nominate 5 best original ideas/innovations of students through this website.

The scheme encourages them to address societal needs through science and technology by developing original ideas. The selected students will receive a one-time award of ₹10,000.

Eligibility:

To be eligible, the applicant must:

- be between 10 and 15 years old
- be currently studying in Classes 6 to 10

Note: Each school can nominate 2-3 students.

Benefits:

- Selected students will receive a one-time award of ₹10,000.
- In addition, students selected for the National Level Exhibition & Project Competition (NLEPC) will receive mentoring from reputed technology institutions and funding for prototype development.
