The Chairman of the Committee and the Head of the Department invited the members to the PAQIC meeting. The meeting commenced at 2:00 PM, and the agenda was discussed in detail.

- **Agenda Item 1: Review of Results and CO attainment of the III Semester, V Semester and VII Semester 2025-26**

The Chairman presented the Course Outcome (CO) attainment analysis of III, V and VII Semester courses for the academic year 2025–26. It was observed that CO1 in Discrete Mathematics and CO2 in Software Engineering were not attained to the expected target levels. The committee discussed the reasons for low attainment and suggested submission of action taken reports for all courses, including remedial measures, additional practice sessions, assignment improvements and continuous monitoring of student performance.

Resolution: The PAQIC reviewed the CO attainment report and approved the submission and implementation of action taken reports for all courses to improve attainment levels in subsequent semesters.



- **Agenda Item 2: Review on Feedback received various stakeholders to prepare BT25 III yr and IV year course structure and Syllabus.**

The Chairman presented the feedback received from various stakeholders during the meeting for preparation of the BT25 III Year and IV Year course structure and syllabus. Stakeholders from industry, academia, alumni and employers emphasized the need to strengthen emerging technology domains in the curriculum to enhance student employability and industry readiness. It was suggested to include courses and laboratory components related to Generative AI, Chatbots, Natural Language Processing (NLP) and Reinforcement Learning in the upcoming BT25 regulations. The committee discussed the relevance of these advanced subjects in view of current industry trends, research opportunities and future technological advancements.

Resolution: The PAQIC reviewed the stakeholder feedback and approved the inclusion of Generative AI, Chatbots, NLP and Reinforcement Learning related theory and laboratory courses in the BT25 III Year and IV Year curriculum wherever applicable.

- **Agenda Item 3: Review of Patent publications Carried out by Final year students**

The Chairman presented the details of patent publications carried out by final year students and faculty members during the academic year. It was informed that 10 patents were filed based on innovative ideas and project works developed by final year students. The committee appreciated the efforts of the department and encouraged faculty members to motivate students to convert major projects and research outcomes into patent publications and intellectual property contributions.

Resolution: The PAQIC reviewed and appreciated the patent filing activities and resolved to encourage more students and faculty members to convert innovative major projects into patent publications.

- **Agenda Item 4: Evaluation of Pedagogical Activities and Teaching Methodologies.**

The Committee reviewed the pedagogical activities and innovative teaching methodologies implemented by faculty members. Faculty members were encouraged to upload subject-related lecture videos and learning resources on the college YouTube
